When every group has written something on each chart they will pick one topic and present it in front of the class 3. Survey Activity The students will survey other students and ask questions if they use environmental friendly ways to keep the environment healthy, they will also ask if the ways they are using are personal ways or social ways of keeping the environment healthy. 4. Complete the slogans with the given words : The students will fill the blanks in the given slogans on environment they will be using the given word list and memorize them and the recite in front of the class 5. Poem on how to keep the environment healthy: They will memorize the poem and recite it as a group . 6. Scenario Activity: You are opening an environmental club in school.
