### **Program Theme & Overview**

## Program Can-Do Statement & Performance Task #

The program Can-Do Statement and performance assessment task were developed in stage 1 & 2 of the curriculum.

Program Can-Do Statement:

I can formally introduce my best friend in good details using positive character traits, his/her talents and acievements and some of his/her shortcomings.

Performance Assessment Task:

After reading a short passage about formal introduction, students will make note of some positive character traits, talents and achievements of the person as well as some of the shortcomings. Students will then narrate and give formal introduction of their best friend, including the key vocabulary words and sentence structure, listing their hobbies, talents and achievements some of the shortcomings in their habbits.
